The Troy-Hayner Cultural Center is pleased to present Order and Fire. The exhibit of pottery by Troy artist Philip Matthews will be on display January 10th through February 23rd. An artist reception is scheduled for Sunday, January 12th from 2:00 to 4:00 pm. Attending the reception is a wonderful way to meet the artist and gain insight into his work and process. The reception and exhibit are free and open to the public. Artist Philip Matthews has always been interested in the intersection of art and functionality, specifically everyday ceramic objects as a canvas for visual exploration. Bold graphics and clean lines. Spontaneous color and dramatic contrast. Order and Fire is inspired by the juxtaposition of these visual languages on a functional surface. Using a combination of Raku and traditional techniques, vinyl resists and open flame were used to produce visually rich and tactile surfaces that value pleasing forms and utilitarian functionality.

National Afro-American Museum and Cultural Center (Wilberforce)

Through 2024 Although often misunderstood by the West, African art had an enormous impact on the world. While

Africans created objects for culturally specific functions, their aesthetics challenged Western society and shaped its perceptions. This exhibit presents the relationship between the aesthetic and cultural functions of African art objects and the historical context of their global influence. The exhibition addresses modern questions of cultural appropriation, representation, and repatriation in presenting this updated interpretation. Using the museum's extensive African Art collection, Wright State University Graduate Students in Public History assisted the NAAMCC curatorial staff with its creation.

African Americans Fighting for a Double Victory Through 2025 Explore the many ways that African Americans served our country in the military and on the home front during World War II, through this exhibit of World War II materials from National Afro-American Museum & Cultural Center collections. Discover the art of Charles Alston, commissioned by the Office of War Information to promote the war effort among African Americans, explore stories of the Tuskegee Airmen, the Red Ball Express, the Triple Nickels and Wilberforce-area veterans, and get a look at the impact World War II veterans had on the advances in civil rights that followed the war.

Queens of the Heartland Through 2025 The Queens of the Heartland-the exhibit is part of the Ohio History Connection and National Afro-American Museum and Cultural Center Women's Suffrage Centennial celebration. The exhibit will feature the stories of 30 Ohio African American women who were a significant influence in the Suffrage and Civil Rights Movements. The Queens of the Heartland exhibit will tell the stories of pioneering women through panel text as well as three-dimensional objects. This exhibit will also feature portrait illustrations of these historical figures by New York artist Nichole Washington whose current work focuses on identity and celebrates African American women.

Rhythm of Revolution-The Transformative Power of Black Art 1619 to the Present Through 2024 The National Afro-American Museum and Cultural Center in Wilberforce, Ohio, presents a new exhibit called Rhythm of Revolution-The Transformative Power of Black Art 1619 to the Present. The exhibit maps the visual flow of artistic, cultural, social, and political change in America from 1619 to the present day. Using three-dimensional objects from the NAAMCC collections, Rhythm of Revolution explores how Black artists, religious leaders, and activists worked within their spheres of influence to transform Ohio and our nation. Over time, these known and unknown change agents connected deeply rooted African traditions, interpreted those traditions to attempt to solve contemporary challenges, and worked to pave the way forward into a better future. The National Afro-American Museum & Cultural Center opened to the public in April 1988 and is celebrating its 30th anniversary. The museum is the permanent home of one of the nation's largest collections of Afro-American materials, with over 9,000 artifacts and artwork, 350 manuscript collections, and thousands of photographs. Items include Alex Haley's typewriter and his final draft of *Roots*, a buffalo hide coat worn by a Buffalo Soldier, Gregory Hines's tap shoes, collections representing the Black Arts Movement of the 1960s, and a vast collection of Black dolls, including the recently donated Lillian Bartok Collection.

January's Visiting Artist of the Month is Rachel Dillabaugh, who focuses on painting landscapes that simplify the intricate details of nature to highlight the mood of a scene via color and light. Throughout 2024 she added flowers to her subject matter. Rachel primarily uses oil paints, but brushes play a minor role in her work as she prefers using palette knives, which allow her to add layers of texture. She loves to paint en plein air (outdoors) and photography is a huge part of her process. Rachel received her BFA from Wright State University in 2019 and her MA from Fort Hays State University in 2024. January's Artist of the Month is the talented Jim Hayes who's shown his work in local galleries for decades. A longtime photographer, Hayes, a Cincinnati native who grew up in Dayton, said he started as many fathers do: snapping pictures at his children's sports games. Jim loves to travel and the many places he's visited are evident in his gallery space at Art Encounters. Now that he's formally studied the art, "I always try to make photographs, not just take pictures," he explains. He credits his high school art teacher who got him interested in three of his favorite things: sports, cars, and photography.
